Blue Foundry Bank reserves the right to modify or discontinue the ATM fee rebate at any time.

During any statement cycle, per Regulation D, you may not make more than 6 withdrawals or transfers to another account of yours or to a third party by means of a preauthorized or automatic transfer or telephone order or instruction, computer transfer, or by check, draft, debit card or similar order to a third party. These limits do NOT apply to cash withdrawals from your account or to fund transfers made to another Blue Foundry Bank account if conducted by mail or at an ATM.
