<b>The Giving Basket</b>	Assist chairperson with organizing and collecting Thanksgiving dinner items for baskets to be donated to families in need. Inquire about donations to complete the baskets, assemble baskets and deliver.
<b>Bake or Bring</b>	Take part in a committee of parent/teachers called upon for home baked or store bought snacks and drinks for various fundraising events and school events.
<b>Trunk or Treat</b>	Help with set-up, clean-up, organize and sell food, snacks and beverages, assist and chaperon children in bounce houses, organize and assist at arts and craft tables, etc.
<b>Halloween Dance</b>	Parents of 6 <sup>th</sup> , 7 <sup>th</sup> , & 8 <sup>th</sup> graders to help decorate, chaperone dance, assist with set up and clean up.
<b>Holiday Sale</b>	Assist the Event Coordinators with set-up, help students with their purchases and breakdown.
<b>Breakfast w/Santa</b>	Help the Event Coordinator with planning, setting-up and cleaning-up.
<b>Pre-K thru 2<sup>nd</sup> Party</b>	Help chairperson with theme, organizing and setting up for the event, clean up and gathering snack donations, etc.
<b>Fun Night!</b>	Parents of 3 <sup>rd</sup> , 4 <sup>th</sup> and 5 <sup>th</sup> graders to help chairperson gather donations for snacks and refreshments, decide on theme and activities as well as chaperone event.
<b>Picture Day</b>	Assist photographer with correct order of forms and students, help coordinate classes for picture taking. Assist 8 <sup>th</sup> graders with cap and gown.
<b>Book Fair</b>	Help the event coordinator with set-up and breakdown, assist students with purchases, etc.
<b>Staff Appreciation</b>	Assist the event coordinator with shopping, baking donations, and setting-up before school and clean up.
<b>Field Day</b>	Help keep score for events, replenish water stations, and cut watermelons, scoop ice-cream and assist with other various activities.
<b>Scholarships</b>	Assist chairperson with screening and selection of essays of students that have graduated from Midland and will be entering college.
<b>Grants</b>	Help research and apply for grants on behalf of the Midland School students.
